### Crane operator fined \$8000 for near miss

A crane operator has been fined \$8000 in the Fremantle  
Magistrates Court over an incident in which a crane collapsed on a  
construction site, narrowly missing workers.

Bruce Edwin Bannister pleaded guilty to two charges - failing to  
ensure his own safety and failing to ensure the safety of others.

WorkSafe WA said in March 2009, Mr Bannister drove a crane to a  
construction site where a two-storey house was being built. He set up  
the crane with one of its supports (an outrigger) on soft sand and  
another support (the front jack) on a pile of bricks.

The dogman was not sure the crane could reach the necessary  
position, so he asked Mr Bannister to do a practice run without the  
load attached.

During the practice run, the supports collapsed under the crane and it  
tipped over onto its right side and came to rest on the building and  
scaffolding. The crane did not hit anyone on the site, but one worker  
had to run to avoid the falling crane.

WorkSafe WA Commissioner Nina Lyhne said today that safe  
procedures were extremely important around equipment such as  
cranes. "Setting up a crane on a solid foundation is one of the  
fundamental principals of crane operation, but one that was not  
observed in this case," Ms Lyhne said.

"The crane operator placed himself and another four employees in  
danger of being injured or even killed by the crane when it fell. If the  
crane had been loaded, the danger would have been even greater."
