# April 2011 NEWSLETTER



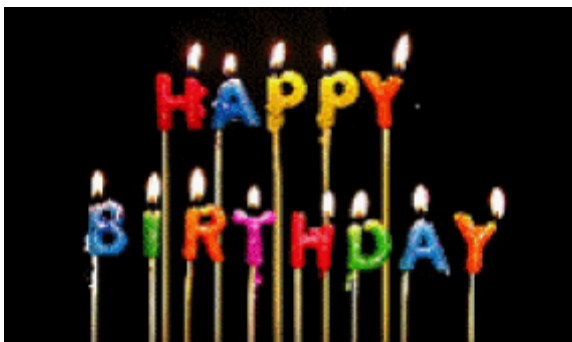
With Easter just around the corner we'd like to wish you a safe and enjoyable time (whether you are at, or away from work).

A WorkSafe inspection program on noise management in workplaces has revealed that noise remains a widespread hazard in WA workplaces. Inspectors visited 94 workplaces in the metropolitan area and the Bunbury and Karratha regions last year, identifying potential noise hazards in almost a third of the workplaces visited.

The health effects of exposure to excessive noise are often not felt until much later, making it crucial to manage noise in a proactive manner before the damage is done. WorkSafe will conduct a free lunchtime '4-thought' session on April 20 in Welshpool on the subject of practical noise control.
